

## THE PARKLANDS of Floyds Fork

21st Century Parks is a nonprofit organization dedicated to extending Frederick Law Olmsted's vision of "bringing nature into neighborhoods" into the 21st century. We have preserved over 3,800-acres of land for The Parklands of Floyds Fork as a unique urban escape. The Parklands will consist of four major parks tracing Floyds Fork Creek with:

- Almost 2,000 acres of forestland and hundreds of acres of restored native meadowlands;
- 100 miles of new trails for hiking, biking, and horseback;
- Restored wetlands and streambanks, and 22 miles of canoe trail along Floyds Fork;
- The preservation of several hundred acres to support active and sustainable agriculture; and
- A recreational wonderland with children's playgrounds, spraygrounds, walking paths, picnic facilities, sports fields, fishing holes, canoe launches, a dog park, and much more.
